WHEREAS by a scheme governing the award of scholarships for a degree course or for professional /SIX Form training at **UNIVERSITY OF GHANA** a person awarded a scholarship is required to enter into a bond duly to comply with the following directions:

- (a) to complete the course for which the scholarship was awarded and follow the directions laid down in the Rules governing the award of scholarships tenable in Ghana under the Ghana Government Scholarships Scheme or any other directions that may be given in connection with such course by the Government;
- (b) except the case of a Sixth Former upon completion of his/her authorized studies to rejoin or to enter service in the civil establishment or armed forces of Ghana if called upon to do so. In the capacity for which his/her course of instruction is adjudged by the Government to have rendered him/her competent and to continue in that service for a period of five years or if not called upon to rejoin or enter such service to undertake any service. In Ghana for which his/her course of instruction is considered by the Government or by some person authorized by him to have rendered him/her competent for a period of five years.

2. AND WHEREAS the said **ROBERT KWAKU BOATENG** has been awarded a scholarship for a degree course or for professional/Sixth Form training at **UNIVERSITY OF GHANA, LEGON**

3. NOW the above written obligations are conditioned to be void in case the said **ROBERT KWAKU BOATENG** shall:

- (a) complete the course for which the scholarship was awarded and follow the directions laid down in the Rules governing the award of scholarships tenable in Ghana under the Ghana Government Scholarships Scheme or any other directions that may be given in connection with such course by the Government;

(b) except the case of a Sixth Former upon completion of his/her authorized studies to rejoin or to enter service in the civil establishment or armed forces of Ghana if called upon to do so. In the capacity for which his/her course of instruction is adjudged by the Government to have rendered him/her competent and to continue in that service for a period of five years or if not called upon to rejoin or enter such service to undertake any service. In Ghana for which his/her course of instruction is considered by the Government or by some person authorized by him to have rendered him/her competent for a period of five years.

Otherwise and in the event of a breach of any or all of the above conditions the same shall remain in full force and virtue and the said sum of Gh¢ SUM OF ALL EXPENSES i.e. SALARY, GoG/DONAR SPONSORSHIP Cedis andpesewas) plus an interest thereon of five per centum shall be forthwith payable to the Government of Ghana in respect of such breach by way of liquidated damages and not as a penalty.

**RULES GOVERNING THE AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS TENABLE IN GHANA UNDER
GHANA GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS SCHEME**

Every person awarded a Ghana government scholarship tenable in Ghana is required to comply with the following rules:

- a) to proceed to the University of Ghana or the University of Science and Technology or to any secondary school or to any other institutions as may be directed and to begin his/her studies at such time as is appointed, unless he/she is prevented from so doing by sickness proved by a certificate from a government medical officer or by circumstances beyond his/her control, recognized as such for the period of **DURATION OF PROGRAMME (i.e. ONE)** years;
- b) to reside in the said college, school or a hostel or lodgings approved by the awarding authority;
- c) to devote his/her whole time to following the course of instruction for which the scholarship is awarded unless permission to undertake other work or modify his/her course in content or duration granted;
- d) not to engage in any occupation or activity which is considered detrimental to his/her progress in the course of studies prescribed for him/her and his/her health;
- e) to satisfy the awarding authority as to attendance, conduct and progress by reports from the head of institution, or his representative at which he/she is studying;
- f) at all times to conduct himself/herself as an honest and faithful student and the best of his/her power and ability to observe, obey and perform such instructions and directions as shall be given from time to time;
- g) as and when, called upon by the awarding authority to cause himself/herself to be medically examined and render a report on his/her health to such authority, it being understood that the scholarship may be suspended or terminated if he/she is declared by a medical officer approved for the purpose of these rules as unfit to complete his/her studies owing to illness or if he/she is absent from his/her studies for more than six months owing to illness;
- h) to sit for and pass any prescribed examinations or approved group of examinations within the time fixed by the authorities of the institution at which he/she is attending or by the awarding authority unless he/she is prevented from so doing by sickness proved by a certificate from the Government Medical Officer or by circumstances beyond his/her control recognized as such by the awarding authority;
- i) not to marry during the tenure of his/her scholarship without permission of the awarding authority;
- j) whether or not permission to marry is granted, to complete the course without interruption in a satisfactory manner and to fulfil all the conditions under which the scholarship was awarded.

2. The scholarship may be suspended or terminated if the person awarded scholarship fails to comply with any of the foregoing rules.

3. Whenever direction, intention, approval or consent is indicated or required by any of the foregoing rules the same may be given or signified by any officer in the Ministry of **APPLICANTS ORGANIZATION** Department who holds an appointment not below the rank of Assistant Secretary.

4. All Ghana Government scholars will be required to sign the following declaration in the presence of a Magistrate or an officer of the Ministry **APPLICANTS ORGANIZATION** Department not below the rank of Assistant Secretary:

I **ROBERT KWAKU BOATENG** hereby declare that I have read the foregoing rules and agree that the scholarship awarded to me shall be governed by these rules, which is to say, that in the event of a breach of any of the above rules by me, my scholarship may be suspended or terminated forthwith.
