GHANA CIVIL SERVICE NOMINATION CRITERIA FOR "2023 CIVIL SERVICE AWARDS"



Nominees for the **"2023 Civil Service Awards**" (Professional and Sub-Professional Category) must fulfill the following criteria:

- 1. Be a Civil Service staff on grades analogous to Deputy Director and below,
- 2. A permanent employee working full-time and must have worked in the Service for a minimum of 3 years.
- 3. Successfully completed his/her appraisal and attained a score of 85% and above;
- 4. Exhibited excellent work and a dedication to completing assigned tasks;
- 5. Shown initiative and a proactive approach to going above and beyond the call of duty;
- 6. Encouraged and facilitated coworkers' performance and accomplishments as well as clients' satisfaction:
- 7. Exhibited excellent abilities and expertise in the duties given by his or her organisation and the Civil Service:
- 8. Made a substantial contribution for devising solutions to problems that the Ministry/Department (MD) and the Civil Service were confronting (e.g., being innovative);
- 9. Known for having a stellar attendance record and being on time for work;
- 10. Dependable and capable of finishing projects on schedule; and
- 11. Demonstrated positivity at work with high standards of honesty and work ethics.

Requirement from Nominees Institution:

Nominees' organization are expected to:

- Constitute a committee of not less than three (3) members (Chaired by the Director responsible for HR) to assess all suitable nominees across the various Directorates /Units/Region including those on secondment in quasi agencies etc.
- Submit a report of a competitive selection process of nominees with all committee members signing the report.
- Ensure that there is a one-page letter endorsed by Chief Director/Head of Department on the Nominees (indicating why the choice).
- Ensure that the submitted Nomination forms include relevant documents (completed 2023 staff Appraisal Instrument etc.) and submitted on or before the deadline for submission.
